Treasurer's Report

WT Mike Reynolds reported the opening balance for February was \$5114.81 and ended at \$11,713.87. There were \$8252 of deposits with Golf Tournament (\$3420), Fish Fries (\$2216) and Dues (\$1335) making up the major deposits. There were \$1653 of withdrawals with Fish Fry expense (\$1147) and Supreme per Capita Assessment (\$204) making up the major withdrawals.

Staddon-Cain Investment Account lost \$81.65 in market value adjustment, and \$95.50 in Dividends and Interest resulting in a closing balance of \$22,582.31.
