Membership Meeting: April 20, 2021

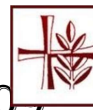
Note: This was a virtual meeting.

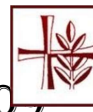
1. Thanks to the Brother Knights who participated during Palm Sunday and Holy Thursday.
