- Thanks to all for your work and willingness to volunteer for our activities.
- Continue to stay current with the Protecting Gods Children. We need a couple more members to sign up for the Safe Environment program which is good for 3 years.
- 35<sup>th</sup> anniversary/Christmas pot luck social meeting was a huge success. We honored our charter members that were able to attend. We awarded each charter member a certificate and a wooden cross. The very first Grand Knight of the council, Al Livelsberger, received a special award and accolades. The members present then gave Brother Al a hardy round of applause. The 35<sup>th</sup> anniversary ceremony was also attended by WDD Ron Schwartz and State Warden Sergio Miranda. WDD Ron also awarded the Columbian Award to PGK Dennis Machuga for attaining all the requirements for the prior year during the ceremony as well. Members present then gave PGK Dennis a round of applause as well.
- There is a new Columbiettes Liaison Officer – BK Carl Darkes..
- The Columbiettes are requesting some help from the 4<sup>th</sup> degree members with a upcoming patriotic event.
- Fr Paul's going away party will be next June, but Fr Paul just wants soda and chips.
