Total meals were 85 which is one of our largest. Many mothers still made donations anyway. We collected \$205.00 + \$45.00 in donations. We also used a \$50.00 give card to offset some expenses. BK Pat agreed to do this campaign again but if anyone wants to give it a crack let him know, please.
- Miscellaneous DGK thanked BK Dave Kempka for his work to help give the stove a good cleaning. We are still working on forming a 1st Degree Team. We would encourage anyone that can to join the team.
- Dash Game Report: Brother Chuck Tierney reporting: (33:00) We had our first Dash Game last evening working our new assignment. Thanks to BK Jim Valentine working his first game and thanks to our veteran, Jean Dion. We made \$175.00 with little effort compared to our work in the Club. Easy Money. No set up or clean up. Half the staff can leave early if the attendance is light.
- Staddon-Cain Report: Brother Chuck Tierney reporting: (34:21)
 We have one application so far from BK Stan's son Jacob, looks like a great application that meets all the requirements.

- Report of the Collumbiettes: WGK Pete reporting for BK Carl who is away.
 - The Columbiettes had to cancel their new Officer Installation as it conflicted with a Dash Game. We have agreed to let them join us on June 19th after the 7pm Mass and hold their Installation before we have ours. There will be a social with them afterwards. The Council will provide refreshments.
- O New Business: (37:47
 - WGK Pete passed a going away card for Fr Paul for everyone to sign. We have reserved the grill
 for cooking hot dogs at Fr Paul's going away picnic. The council is to supply just the hot dog buns
 for the event. Should cost around \$250.00. A motion to spend the money was made, seconded and
 Passed.
 - **BK Dennis Machuga** reported on the State Convention activities. (39:15) **State Convention** was held in Raleigh on April 26th & 27th. A program was passed around for the members present to review. Recruitment was a big goal for the fraternal year. State is looking to add 900 new members and as of the date of the convention we were at 693. Request was made to all the councils to add a couple more members so that we could finish strong. The Knights worldwide have made \$185 million dollars in contributions. 76 million hours of Service. 7,600 wheelchairs have been donated and there are currently 2 million members. The insurance company is the 6th largest insurance company in the U.S. The Council officers will work to get a copy of the video that was played at the convention for the members to view.

Hurricane relief was a big topic as well, there were some amazing stats regarding all the contributions to that relief effort.

Supreme Convention is August 6th thru 8th in Minneapolis, 6 delegates were selected from the State. New Officers were also elected at the convention. The 2020 convention will be the last weekend in April in Concord at the Great Wolf Lodge. The focus next year will be on the Family.

Only one Mid-Year meeting next year for the District Deputies who will report back to the Councils. **Report on LAMB** was given, \$557,000.00 was collected last year, however the number of councils participating is down compared to 2007.

State Golf Tournament: will be a new format next year. There will be regional tournaments and teams will be selected from those winners to play in the State tournament on the Thursday before the State Convention.

State Raffle: \$157,781.00 in sales, half will come back to the Councils (almost \$79,000).

State Secretary report: Bishop Relief Fund collected \$2,200.00, Culture of Life \$4,700.00, Penny a Day \$4,500.00.

High Point of the Convention was to attend Mass at the new (2017) Holy Name of Jesus Cathedral in Raleigh. Might be a future road trip for the Council??

The State Chaplin did a presentation of the evolution of the Church i.e. Vatican I vs. Vatican II. The focus has shifted from individual faith to a more evangelical concept of becoming more involved in community efforts such as Soup Kitchens etc. To get out and spread your faith.

There is a relic of St. JOHN VIANNEY sponsored by the Knights that will be available at the Cathedral of St Patrick's in Charlotte this coming Saturday and Sunday.

BK Dan Emmi informed the Council that the Parish wants to borrow our mobile sign in June for a food drive. This can be reserved thru Bernadette in the office.

BK Steve Salvitti mentioned the upcoming Welcome Weekend Program. This is the 2nd year for this program. There is a lot of effort put into the development and production of this program but there has been disappointing sign up so far. If anyone is interested in attending this event, please sign up as soon as possible. We really need to increase the attendance if we are going to keep this program going. Otherwise we will be forced to cancel the program.

Fr Paul: There has been a recent donation to another Scholarship fund at Holy Cross that has (53:05) been dormant. Fr Paul inquired if the Knights would be able to administer this fund along with the Staddon Caine fund that we already manage. Bernadette would have the information about the fund. BK Chuck will follow up to get all the details.
