We operate with a focus on delivering positive outcomes in an efficient manner and I'd like to note some of our most recent accomplishments.

- **We've designed and implemented our program**, which focuses on life skills, executive functions, workforce development, and transition planning.
- **85% of our veterans have steady employment or income through our VHVH Works™ employment partnerships.** Participating partners include the Winston-Salem Dash at Truist Ballpark, Spectra Food Services at Wake Forest University, Rhino Sports and Entertainment Services at Virginia Tech University, and Ezekiel AME Zion Church's Summer Food Program.
- **87% are enrolled in education or job skills training partnerships** at places like Forsyth Tech Community College and Goodwill Industries of North West North Carolina.
- **And 80% of our graduates are moving into permanent housing.**

On behalf of the VHVH family I'm grateful for your partnership in restoring the home, health, and spirit of our veterans.
