Treasurer's Report

WT Mike Reynolds reported the opening balance for March was \$9981 and ended at \$14,211. There were \$8279 of deposits from Golf Tournament, fish fry, dues and pancake breakfast. There were \$4049 of withdrawals for fish fry, lingering expenses for the Octoberfest, and pancake breakfast.

The Staddon-Cain Investment Account began with a balance of \$24,382, lost \$189 in market value adjustment, and gained \$101 in Dividends and Interest resulting in a closing balance of \$24,292. See the list and amounts under New Business.
